# Be Careful to Prevent Fires

#### ■ Install Residential Fire Alarms

It is required to install fire alarms in bedrooms. Depending on the layout of your home, you may also need to install them near stairways. Installing fire alarms is mandatory for all homes. While installation in kitchens is not required, it is strongly recommended.

### ■ Preventing Fires at Home

Prevent fires through everyday habits and safety measures at home.

- Do not place flammable items near stoves or heaters.
- Use fire-resistant bedding and curtains.

## ■ Be Careful with Cigarette Fires

Cigarette fires are hard to notice and can grow into large fires while you're sleeping or away from home. Clean ashtrays regularly, and soak cigarette butts in water before throwing them away.

#### ■ Take Steps to Prevent Arson

- Lock storage sheds and garages, turn on outdoor lights, and keep the area around your home well-lit.
- Do not leave flammable items such as cardboard boxes around your house.
- Do not store items in shared areas of apartment buildings.
- Put out your garbage on the morning of the collection day.
